Day 1 – 30 May 2026, Saturday

Mumbai → Athens → Santorini

You will be flying Mumbai → Athens → Santorini (you will be completing your immigration in Athens, collect your bags and check in for your domestic flight to Santorini). Upon arrival at Santorini, you will collect your bags, your driver will meet you at the exit, transfer to the hotel.

Dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight in Santorini. **(Meals Included: Dinner)**

Notes:

- Standard Check In Time: 3.00 pm or later. In case our flight arrives in the morning, we may cover some sightseeing to fill up the gap.
- We suggest that you take care of all your travel documents, valuables, currency and have emergency contacts handy during your trip.
- As per Schengen visa rules, we have to process your Schengen Visa from the country we are entering to, in this case it will be Greece as our trip is to Greece. If the visa is processed from a different country, your entry may be banned.



Day 2 – 31 May 2026, Sunday

We start with Continental Breakfast at the hotel and after breakfast proceed for Walking tour at **Fira** – a beautiful town with white-washed houses built on the top of impressive Caldera cliffs. After the walking tour we visit **Lost Atlantis 9D theatre** and embark on a journey in Greek History, Mythology, Philosophy and Geology.

Red Beach

Famous for its striking, dramatic Crimson cliffs and dark volcanic pebbles.

Prophet Elias Lookout

Located near Pyrgos, the island's highest vantage point at 567 metres above sea level, offering 360° panoramic views.

Local Winery

Wine tasting and Lunch at the winery.

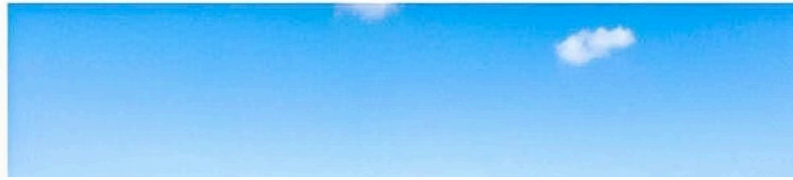
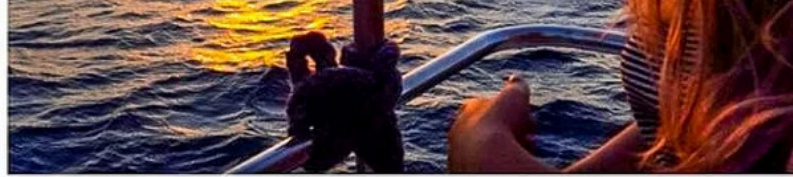
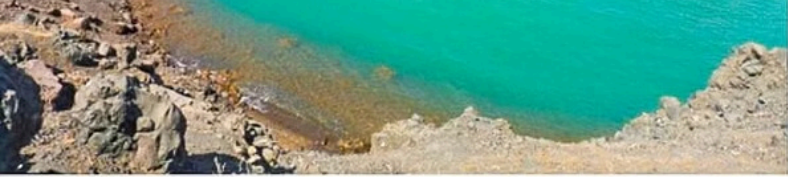
Megalochori Village

One of the island's oldest villages, dating back to the 17th Century, steeped in history and traditional Cycladic Charm.

Oia at Sunset

A world renowned, picturesque village on the northwestern tip of Santorini, famous for its whitewashed houses, iconic blue-domed churches and stunning caldera sunset views. Post Sunset enjoy a Dinner experience at Oia.

Day 3 – 1 June 2026, Monday

Enjoy your Breakfast at the hotel and transfer to Port Kaiki. You will take a **Wooden Boat trip** to the volcano and the hot springs.

Nea Kameni (New Burnt)

You will visit the active craters of the Volcano on top of the Island of Nea Kameni.

Palea Kameni (Old Burnt)

Thermal springs provide natural warm bathing. While the surrounding water and beaches may be cold and winds can be daunting, the thermal springs give an experience of warm water.

After a short stop, you return to Port Kaiki and proceed for lunch. Post lunch visit **Black Beach**. Return to the hotel. In the evening proceed for dinner.

Day 4 – 2 June 2026, Tuesday | Santorini → Mykonos

After early breakfast check out from your hotel and proceed to Santorini Port to board your ferry to Mykonos.

Upon arrival in Mykonos, you will proceed for a walking tour through **Mykonian history alley** – the whitewashed streets. You will learn how the winding streets were designed to confuse the invading pirates.

Manto Square

See the monument of Manto Mavrogenous, a heroine of Greek War of Independence.

Little Venice

One of the most romantic places in Mykonos – elegant and gorgeous old houses situated precariously on the edge of the sea.

Church of Panagia Paraportiani

The most photographed church in Mykonos, located at the entrance of Kastro neighbourhood, right by the sea. Its name (Paraportiani) actually means standing next to the entrance door.

Famous Windmills

An iconic feature of Mykonos which can be seen from almost every corner of Mykonos Town.

Proceed for Lunch, post lunch proceed to your hotel, free time in the afternoon to do as you please. In the evening we proceed for Dinner to Indian restaurant followed by a **Old Town Experience at night**.

Day 5 – 3 June 2026, Wednesday | In Mykonos

After the visit proceed for Lunch at Paradise Beach. Dinner at restaurant and return to your hotel.

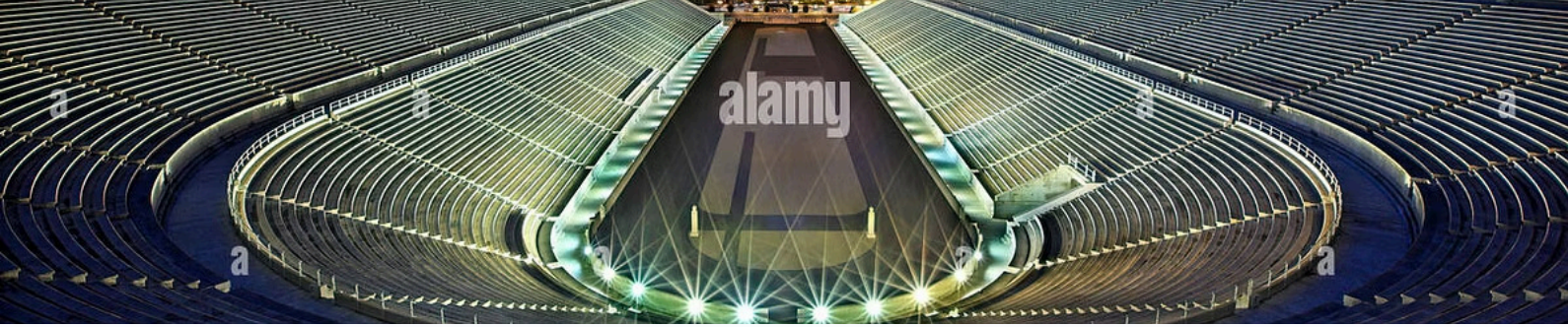
Overnight in Mykonos. **(Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)**

Day 6 – 4 June 2026, Thursday | Mykonos → Athens

Enjoy a relaxed breakfast at your hotel, morning at leisure. Transfer to Indian restaurant for lunch. After lunch you transfer to Mykonos Port for your ferry to Athens.

Upon arrival in Athens, transfer to Indian restaurant for dinner. After Dinner proceed to your hotel.

Day 7 – 5 June 2026, Friday | In Athens

Enjoy your breakfast at the hotel and proceed for sightseeing tour of Athens. Start with a photo stop at the **Panathinaiko Stadium** where the first Olympic Games took place in 1896. It is the Only stadium made out of White Marble.

Proceed through the city, passing by **Zappeion** and **Temple of Olympian Zeus**, later you will then pass the **Athens Trilogy** which includes the University of Athens, the Academy of Athens, and the National Library. Continue further towards Acropolis via National Garden, via other historical monuments.

Acropolis is an ancient citadel located on a rocky outcrop above the city of Athens and contains the remains of several ancient buildings of great architectural and historical significance, the most famous being the **Parthenon**. You will visit the monument and the Acropolis Museum.

After the sightseeing tour, you proceed for lunch at Indian restaurant. Post lunch we proceed for a **Walking tour of Plaka and Monastiraki**.

Plaka

Athens' oldest, most picturesque neighborhood, known as the "Neighborhood of the Gods" due to its location directly under the Acropolis. It features a labyrinth of narrow, pedestrianized cobblestone streets, neoclassical architecture, and vibrant bougainvillea. It offers abundant shopping, traditional tavernas, & cafes.

Monastiraki

A vibrant, historic neighborhood and major tourist hub in the heart of Athens, Greece, renowned for its bustling flea market, eclectic shopping, and ancient landmarks. Centered around a lively square near a 10th-century church, it offers a blend of Ottoman-era history, rooftop cafes with Acropolis views,.

After the walking tour, you proceed for a traditional Greek Dinner at a local restaurant. After dinner, proceed to your hotel.

Overnight in Athens. **(Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner**



Day 8 – 6 June 2026, Saturday | In Athens

Breakfast at the hotel. Proceed for sightseeing tour of Athens, start with a walking tour. During the tour visit the **Ancient Agora (Market) of Athens**. The Ancient Agora, where the place that ancient Greeks used to do their trades, but also used to gather to discuss city matters, thus, creating the idea of Democracy.

In this magnificent walking tour, we will see the **Stoa of Attalos**, originally erected during the 2nd cent. BC as a gift of the king of Pergamon, Attalos II, to Athens and was one of the world's first shopping malls, which was 116 meters in length and two floors high, supported by Doric, Ionic and parchment columns.

Today we will take you to have a **street food experience in Athens**. After lunch join a **pottery workshop**, for a hands-on pottery workshop where you'll create your very own ceramic mug from scratch!

Evening dinner at Restaurant.
